TREASURER'S REPORT: Chief Wilkes reviewed the Treasurers Report. Appendix A

CORRESPONDENCE/PUBLIC COMMENTS: Chief Wilkes stated the Moreno Family sent a thank you letter to the firefighters for the CZU Complex.

OLD BUSINESS: FIREHOUSE: Chief Wilkes reported to the board the concrete slab has

been poured. The sewer lateral is hooked up as well. Chief Wilkes stated Scott Herman from the City of Willits assisted us with changes to the water lines. Chief Wilkes was appreciative for his help. Chief Wilkes is expecting the metal building delivery the first week in December. Tom Herman was grateful for the City of Willits for their assistance. Chief Wilkes also informed the board that Michelle is currently working with the Trope Company regarding the furniture. Skip Lucier thanked the Chief for his constant dedication to the firehouse as he is always down at the

site.

NEXUS STUDY: Jim Lance and Blaire Aas are working together to pass an ordinance to allow the district to collect impact fees. We are hoping to get on the agenda soon. Chief Wilkes also called Supervisor Haschak and Ted Williams inquiring about the length of time it is taking to get on the agenda for the county. They are trying to work on it as soon as they can.

USDA GRANT: We are approved to purchase items for the new firehouse through the USDA matching grant. Staff is waiting on a few invoices to finish the purchases so the district can get reimbursed.

NEW BUSINESS:

RESOLUTION 2020-8: Chief Wilkes would like approval from the board to research a Type 3 Engine. Boise Mobile Equipment is the recognized lowest bidder at \$378,962.16 and will be a tag on purchase through the state. Chief Wilkes reviewed Boise Mobile Equipment's breakdown. There will be a few modifications needed such as a 1,000 GPM pump. Our firefighters usually sleep in the engines so the staff would like to upgrade the seating as well. Tom Herman inquired if the paint was two-toned. Chief Wilkes stated the engine will be two-toned. Skip Lucier asked if they will lock in the price. Chief Wilkes stated his goal is to lock in the price as soon as possible since the engine will be 14 months out. Chief Wilkes will also check into financial options for the engine. Nancy Stipe asked if we are still paying on any engines. Chief Wilkes stated just the water tender and will be paid off next year. Chief Wilkes does not want to have more than one engine payment at a time. Motion to accept Resolution 2020-8: Tom Herman 1st; Skip Lucier 2nd. All Ayes.

TRAINING REPORT: Training Chief Eric Alvarez reported the last drill was traffic control and firefighter safety. 5 man company drill was also held which consisted of hose lays, pumping and wearing SCBA gear. Training Chief Alvarez also recorded 8 minute videos for fire prevention week education for the schools to upload on zoom.

Aaron for his hard work.

CHIEF'S REPORT:

Chief Wilkes reported the donation from LEEF helped purchase combustible gas indicators. The indicators have already been used in calls. The LEEF donation has already benefitted the public per Chief Wilkes. The remainder of the donation will be used to purchase wildland turnouts. Chief Wilkes thanked LEEF again for their generous donation. 66 calls were in the month of October. Chief Wilkes thanked the volunteers for their assistance. Training Chief Eric Alvarez, Deputy Chief Thomen and Aaron Branscomb have been working on the helipad and the staff have switched out the windsock on the building. Chief Wilkes was thankful for their time. Chief Wilkes announced as of January 1st, 2021, Howard Forest will be dispatching Little Lake Fire Department. Since 1989, Willits Police Department has been part of our dispatching service. Having multiple dispatchers is getting difficult, therefore dispatching out of one entity will be easier for all. We will still have our contract with the City of Willits and will still use Willits Police Department when needed.
